The Monroe County Department of Public Health issues Quarantine Order for K-12 student exposed to COVID-19.



Student is symptom free for 14 days from their last contact with the COVID 19 case.

AND

Student is released from quarantine by the Monroe County Department of Public Health.



Student can return to school.

Student does not get a COVID-19 test: The student remains in quarantine for 14 days. Student cannot return to school without a

negative COVID-19 test result.



While in quarantine, student has a temperature $>100^{\circ}$ OR has symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches



COVID-19 test result is negative: The student remains in quarantine for the remainder of the 14 days.

COVID-19 test result is positive: The student is placed in Isolation by the MCDPH.





Student is released from Quarantine or Isolation by the MCDPH.
