#### **Exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19:**

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



Student will remain or be sent home and referred to family's health care provider.



# Alternative or No Diagnosis

To return to school, student must be symptom free and obtain:

- An evaluation document from health care provider.
- 2. A lab-confirmed negative COVID-19 test result



## Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Test Result

The MCDPH will place student in isolation, which lasts a minimum of 10 days.

Student can return to school after being released from isolation by the MCDPH.
