SUBJECT: BOOSTER CLUBS/PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER SPONSORING ORGANIZATIONS

Booster clubs or other related organizations exist to promote community support and to raise funds to support school activities. The Board of Education formally recognizes the Churchville-Chili Music Booster Club, the Churchville-Chili Sports Booster Club, the Churchville-Chili Robotics Booster Club, and each school building's Parent Teacher Organizations as the only groups authorized to raise funds using the Churchville-Chili School District name or Saints name/logo under this policy. Organizations of this nature which are recognized by the Board may not discriminate on the basis of sex, color, national origin, ethnic background, disability, religion or any other arbitrary criteria.

As to these organizations recognized above, the Board has the following expectations:

- a) Financial records must be maintained and made available, upon request.
- b) Fund raising activities must be approved in advance by the director/building administrator and superintendent or his/her designee. Approval shall be limited to the type, purpose, date and location of the activity. The District shall have no control over the organization or operation of the activity. Fundraising should benefit students collectively, or in recognized groups, or an agreed upon beneficiary.
- c) Organizations will recognize the finite resources of our community and no one organization will take precedence over the others.
- d) Organizations wishing to make a contribution to the District must adhere to the District's policy regarding the acceptance of gifts.
- e) Fundraising that benefits families/individuals are not tax-deductible and donors will be made aware of this.

The Board reserves the right to revoke recognition of any organization.

Student fundraising activities related to extra-curricular student activities are not covered by this policy. Please refer to policy 7450.
