SUBJECT: STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The development of student intellectual ability, desirable traits of character and qualities of leadership are all achievements the School System desires to encourage and foster. In recognition of outstanding student achievement far in excess of the minimum requirements, the Board of Education supports academic recognition awards. These programs may include honor rolls, honor societies, and special awards.

The Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to develop criteria and procedures for these recognition programs. In all cases, the relationship between the honor and the relevant goal of the school shall be made explicitly clear.
