Dear Churchville-Chili Families,

On Monday, March 29, Governor Cuomo issued an Executive Order for schools to continue providing learning activities and resources to students in lieu of taking their previously scheduled spring break (April 6-10). Over the past few days our staff has been working together to create and post the continuation of learning activities and resources for next week. We recognize that many of you may need to take some time for your families, so we will provide some flexibility in work completion dates.

Given that the district used March 16 as a Conference Day for planning and transition of instruction to at-home learning, teachers will be posting instructional activities and materials online for Friday, April 3.

As a reminder, the Governor closed NYS schools through April 14, with a potential opening on April 15. While the decision whether to open schools may not occur until late next week, we will continue to plan instruction and be prepared should we be able to welcome our students and staff back onsite or provide additional at-home learning resources.

Additionally, I want to provide you with some important updates and reminders as we near the end of our third week of school closure.

Grading:

Elementary - Teachers will be providing feedback through comments, rubric scoring, and self and peer assessment.

Middle School - Students may make up incomplete work through April 17. Teachers will be providing feedback through comments, grades (not averaged currently), rubric scoring, and self and peer assessment.

High School - Students may make up incomplete work through April 17. Teachers will be providing feedback through comments, grades (not averaged currently), rubric scoring, along with self and peer assessment. Make-up work will be accepted to positively impact the March 13 (twenty-five week) grade which represents the third quarter marking period.

Third Quarter Marking Period

Grades K-8 - No report card will be completed or distributed. Teachers will maintain a record of work completed along with feedback provided to students.

Grades 9-12 (including HS credit bearing courses, Grade 7/8 French and Spanish, Grade 8 Algebra, Earth Science and Studio in Art) - The 25 week grade will stand as the third quarter marking period grade and will be posted in the Infinite Campus Portal. Please note: if a student was failing or wants to improve their 25 week marking period grade, each student has the chance to make up or complete missing or failing assignments to improve their “quarter” grade by April 17.

IEP Progress notes (K-12) - Students with Individualized Education Plans will be mailed progress notes for the third quarter. The term “*See Comments*” (SC) will be indicated for each goal. Teachers will provide a comment about the progress students have made both while in school and through remote learning.

Fourth Quarter Marking Period - No decision has been made at this time due to the uncertainty of school closure length. Further, the Board of Regents has not yet determined whether the Regents exams will still be in place for students enrolled in Regents level coursework.

Meals - Free meal pickups will continue on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 11 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. at CES, CRS and the Middle School. Please contact us at 293-1800 x2300 with any questions.

****Exception:** *Meals will be distributed on April 8 which will include meals for April 9 & 10 (no meal distribution will occur on Good Friday, April 10).*
