Dear Churchville-Chili Families,

I would like to provide you with a few updates regarding the budget and our capital project work across the district.

Our budget vote is now scheduled for June 9, 2020 by absentee ballot only. All district households will receive two ballots in the mail between May 27 and June 8. Additional ballots may be requested for qualified household members by calling 293-1800 ext. 2305 or online at: www.cccsd.org/BallotRequest.aspx.

Voter qualifications are:

- You must be a U.S. citizen
- You must be 18 years of age
- You must be a Churchville-Chili resident for at least 30 days prior to vote

All absentee ballots must be received by 5 p.m., June 9, 2020. You can watch the Public Hearing of the budget via livestream on our district website on May 26 at 7 p.m. More information about the Proposed 2020-21 School Budget and Board of Education can be found at www.cccsd.org/BudgetDevelopment.aspx.

The concession stand at the stadium is also underway with the recent installation of steel beams and columns. Special thanks to Assemblyman Harry Bronson for the allocation of funds for this endeavor.



Playground colors have been selected by our CES and CRS students, along with a special piece of equipment. We are looking forward to beginning that work in mid to late June in order to open the playgrounds by the beginning of school in September.



There will be some additional work at CES which includes the replacement of windows (continuation of prior work), kitchen renovation and equipment upgrades, and a new public address system.

Our administrative team has been developing a return to school plan for the fall, along with a timeline for students and staff to return to school in June to pick up their belongings, yearbooks, and related materials. In addition, this will provide a chance for students to return textbooks and resources that won't be needed during the summer.

I continue to thank you for your patience as we finalize year-end activities and events, as well as coordinate a new way to end the school year. We hope to communicate detailed information later this month.
