**Directions:**

Students *applying* for NHS should list any volunteer work they did in grades 9-12. For the application, we are looking to see that you have done some community service during high school. Service should be complete to be listed on this form, not projected. The signature of the adult who supervised the service should be acquired if at all possible. In instances where it is impossible, please record their name and phone number. Parent signature is acceptable if the supervisor is not available.

Students *already in* NHS are required to complete 20 or more volunteer hours during each year they are part of the program (20 during junior year and an additional 20 during senior year) The timeframe starts on June 1<sup>st</sup> and is due on the last day of May each year.

**What constitutes Community Service for the purpose of this application/maintaining membership?**

We will **not** count:

- Babysitting younger siblings or yard work for relatives
- Visiting a grandparent or relative in a nursing home
- **Fundraisers for your sports team (or dance, band, chorus, etc.)**
- **New Visions or other school related, required service**
- Working at a family business (even if unpaid)
- **Participation in Government Projects**

We **will** count:

- Service you gave as part of another group (ex: youth group service projects, eagle scout or silver/gold award or other scout project hours, Robotics team service projects, etc...)
- Helping with fundraisers for a non-profit group or benefit for someone who is ill
- Walk or run for a cause, both the time getting pledges and the time spent walking or running/volunteering at the event

Some examples of the community service given by NHS members in previous years:

- Church involvement: helper at Vacation Bible School, church nursery, church festivals, as an altar server, hospitality committee, teaching religious education, mission work, office help, etc.
- Scouting projects: assisting younger troop, aide at summer camp (unpaid)
- Reading to children in the elementary or intermediate school
- Coaching a youth sports team or a summer sports camp (unpaid)
- **Peer Tutoring (Tuesdays and Wednesdays after school)**
- Volunteer at any **NHS offered volunteer opportunity** (roller-skating parties, tutoring needs, “Celebrate Churchville” events, concession stand sales, etc.)
